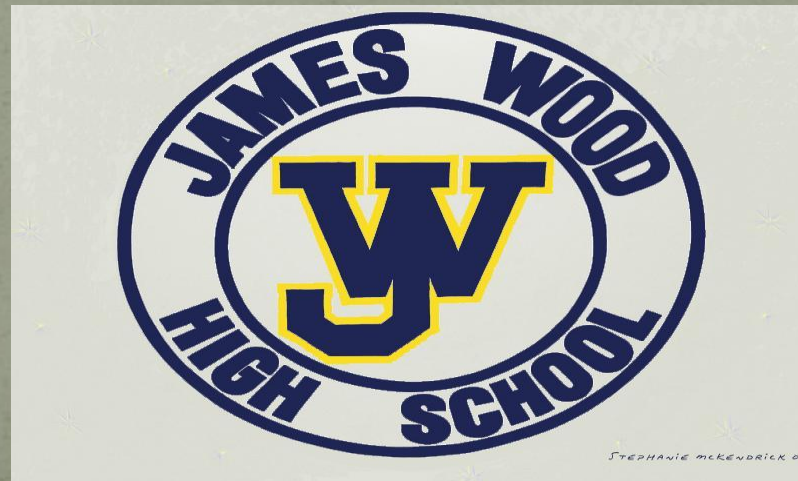

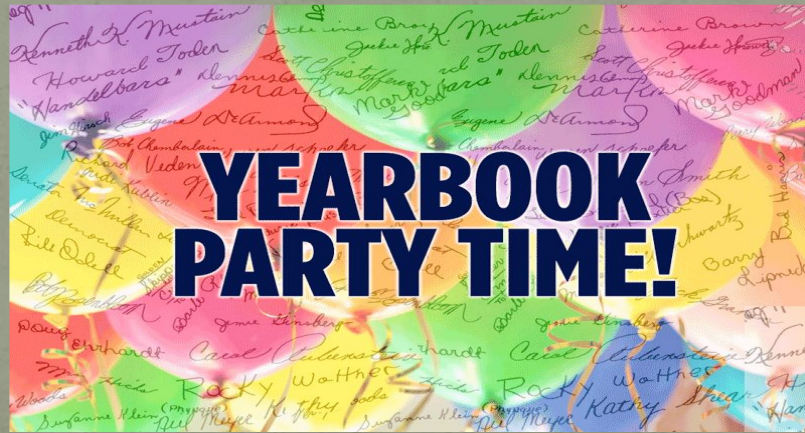
Caps, Gowns & Announcements

- Each student must have a pink transcript release on file.
- All Transcripts are sent electronically thru Parchment
- Registration codes for Parchment were sent to all Juniors on their JWHS e-mail last June. Register using your personal e-mail not the school e-mail

THREE STEPS TO REQUESTING TRANSCRIPTS

- 1. See Mrs. Russell to do a Purple Interview Slip for each college you apply to.**
- 2. Complete online College Application and submit.**
- 3. Request Transcript on Parchment.com.**

Reminders/Suggestions

- All applications need transcripts, as do some scholarships.
- Look through the application with your child. There are deadlines and requests for information that are sometimes missed if only students are looking at the applications.
- Remember to give counselors and teachers two weeks notice prior to deadlines to complete your child's recommendations.

SCHOLARSHIPS & FINANCIAL AID

- Scholarships are posted in the guidance office, school website and a weekly email is sent out with updated scholarship information. See Mrs. Hahn (Guidance Secretary) to be added to the email list.
- Please pay close attention to deadline dates. If a scholarship needs a transcript please be aware that the **completed** scholarship application needs to be turned into the guidance office **2 weeks** prior to the deadline date. That gives the necessary time for the review of the application to make sure everything is complete and so a transcript can be attached and everything mailed.

SCHOLARSHIPS & FINANCIAL AID

- The Local Scholarship Form will be available in January. This form covers approximately 50% of the awards presented to JWHS seniors each spring. These scholarships are given to our seniors by area businesses and organizations in support of student endeavors and accomplishments. Every senior should take the time to fill out this form.
